

**ANNOUNCEMENT**

**REVOKED AND WITHDRAWN INDONESIAN CURRENCY**

As of December 31, 2008, Bank Indonesia, in compliance with Bank Indonesia Regulation (PBI) No. 10/33/PBI/2008 has officially revoked and withdrawn 4 (four) banknotes from circulation. The banknotes revoked and withdrawn are as follows:

Bank Indonesia has revoked and withdrawn Rupiah currency from circulation consisting of:

The rupiah currency revoked and withdrawn from circulation is declared no longer be valid as legal tender starting from 31 December 2008.

The period and location of exchange of rupiah currency revoked and withdrawn from circulation is as followed:  
 Periode Place

- 31 December 2008 – 30 December 2013 Bank Indonesia and/or Commercial Bank
- 31 December 2013 – 30 December 2018 Bank Indonesia

The right to claim the exchange of rupiah currency revoked and withdrawn from circulation shall no longer be valid after 10 (ten) years starting from the date of revocation or 31 December 2018.
